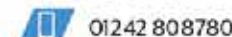
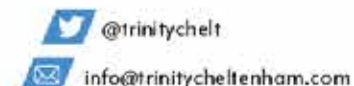
Today we begin our Advent sermon series, Hils Grew will be speaking at both our morning and evening celebrations on 'Gods promised King.'
