There is also a crèche for parents with 0-1 yrs in the side room at the front of church.

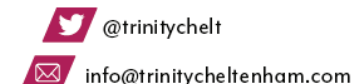
'ALL IN WITH GOD, WITH EACH OTHER AND FOR THE WORLD!'

AUTUMN GIFT DAY AND LAUNCH OF THE 'ROOF+' CONSULTATION

Last Sunday was a moment in the year to celebrate all God's goodness and provision for our church family.

We shared that good progress had been made with regular giving and matching costs with vision. Further commitments now will put us on track to end the year in good shape and able to invest in new areas of mission. If Trinity is your spiritual home, please prayerfully consider the information in the 'Resourcing the Vision leaflet' and on the 'Give' section of the website to start or adjust giving to God's work here.

We also invited the church family to join in three weeks of prayer and discernment around our roof project and potential linked projects. We need a minimum of £500,000 to replace the roof but could also do various works to improve access, gathering space, hospitality and technical facilities at the same time – ranging in cost from £35,000 up to complete replacement of the current foyer for approximately £400,000. Architect's impressions and plans are available on the website and we are also holding a question and prayer gathering on Sunday 13th October 4-5.30pm in Fusion.
