Here are a couple of ways to pray today:

1) For our **Kenyan friends** and partners in the ACK diocese of Kericho.

The travel restrictions, curfews and suspension of all worship services and social gatherings have successfully prevented the spread of Covid-19, but are having major negative impact on livelihoods of many and especially the poor.

- for God to resource the church (also heavily impacted financially) to be able to be generous to the poor and needy during this time.
- for protection and recovery from major floods, massive invasion of locusts and Covid-19 that all may be blessed with a harvest to feed their families.
- for spiritual growth and grace and favour on the church despite multiple challenges and not being able to meet together.
- for God's power in miracles of provision, healing, deliverance, & new birth
- for wisdom for Kenya's leaders, not least Archbishop Jackson

2) Pray **against fear** in all its forms - and for **increase in faith** - for yourself, your family, your church and God's church across the nation.

Repeat these words of promise from the Father - aloud, slowly.

Receive his grace to embrace them and to trust him at a deeper level.
